Albert was born in Tomknitter bridge, Oswaldtwistle, Lancs., in 1907. His mother was Louisa Mary Wallace and his Father is unknown. In 1910, his mother committed suicide in the Mill Lodge near her home in tragic circumstances (for more information on this incident, go to Louisa's page).

Over the next 4 years, Alberts grandparents, John & Rose Ann passed away. At the age of 7 he moved into the home of his uncle Charles and aunt Bella who brought him up alongside their own children, one of whom was already called Albert. Hence, he was always known as 'big Albert'.

In 1934, Albert married Henrietta Holden. They had 4 children: Jean, Sheila, William & Kevin. They lived in Church Kirk but eventually settled in Blackburn.

Albert passed away in 1976 aged 69.
