

FANNY GODWIN WALLACE: 1880-1915

Fanny was born in Colchester, Essex to parents, John Wallace and Rose Ann Godwin in 1880. She had 9 siblings: William, Augustus, Annie (Bella), Louisa, Charles, Margaret, Emily, Walter and Arthur.

The 1901 census has her living as a boarder at 51 Pearl Street Accrington with John & Sarah Fairhurst and their daughter, Ethel. Did this move out of Tomknitter bridge coincide with her Grandmother (see *Rose Ann Aldred) moving in with her parents in the same year after her accident.?

In 1904, Fanny married local man, Albert Wild, and they went on to have only one son: Walter. She died tragically young at the age of 35 years in 1915.

Fanny is likely to be interred along with her parents and brother at Immanuel churchyard, Oswaldtwistle, Lancashire, but this is still to be confirmed.
