LOUISA MARY GODWIN: 1854-1926

Louisa was born in Winchester, Hampshire in 1854. She was the eldest child of parents, Charles Godwin and Rose Ann Aldred. Her siblings were: Fanny, Rose Ann, Alice Maud and Annie Maria.

After growing up with her family in Winchester and Colchester, Essex, the 1881 census has Louisa living with her aunt (Charles's sister) in London where she is employed as a dressmaker.

By 1891, Louisa is living at 77 Avenue Parade, Accrington, Lancashire. Her mother and 3 sisters all lived locally. She was still working as a dressmaker.

The 1901 census has Louisa back in London with her aunt. She was the only sister to have come to Lancashire who chose not to stay.

Louisa remained in the same profession all her life. She passed away on 12 March 1926 while living in Chelsea London. She left £180 5s. 3d.
